Godina 2024. bila je izuzetno dinamična i značajna za Udruženje za prevenciju ovisnosti NARKO-NE, obilježena ključnim iskoracima u oblasti prevencije, edukacije i istraživanja. Kroz strateške projekte i partnerstva, nastavili smo jačati naučno utemeljene pristupe prevenciji ovisnosti u BiH, s posebnim fokusom na mlade ali i stručne saradnike koji rade u ovoj oblasti.

Ove godine proveli smo istraživanja koja su dala dragocjen uvid u obrasce rizičnih ponašanja među mladima, evaluirali smo efikasnost naših programa i nastavili raditi na unapređenju organizacijskih kapaciteta. Posebno ističemo značajan napredak u izradi prve sveobuhvatne Strategije za prevenciju ovisnosti u Federaciji BiH, čime smo učvrstili našu ulogu i doprinos oblikovanju politika u ovoj oblasti.

Naš mentorski program *Stariji brat, starija sestra* obilježio je 20 godina postojanja, dok su programi *Ko zapravo pobjeđuje?*, *Odrastimo zajedno* i *Boombar* nastavili pružati podršku djeci i mladima kroz inovativne i interaktivne aktivnosti. Medijskom kampanjom *Šta stavljáš na kocku?* pokrenuli smo proces senzibiliziranja javnosti o problematici kockanja i klađenja u našem društvu. Unaprijedili smo saradnju s javnim i privatnim sektorom kroz program *Zdravo radno okruženje za sve*, istražujući i adresirajući problem ovisnosti na radnom mjestu. Naš već ustaljeni program *Snažne porodice* se proširio na nekoliko zajednica i nastavio razvijati otpornost na stres kod roditelja i djece.

Ovaj izvještaj pruža detaljan pregled naših aktivnosti, postignuća i naučenih lekcija, kao i smjernice za buduće djelovanje. Zahvaljujemo svim našim partnerima, volonterima i donatorima koji su svojim angažmanom doprinijeli ostvarenju naših ciljeva. Zajedno gradimo društvo u kojem je prevencija prioritet i u kojem svaki pojedinac ima priliku za zdrav i kvalitetan život.

INTRODUCTION

INTRO

The year of 2024 was very dynamic and significant for the Association for Addiction Prevention NARKO-NE, marked with important steps forward in the field of prevention, education and research. We continued strengthening science-based approaches to prevention in Bosnia and Herzegovina through strategic projects and partnerships, focusing on youth and on professionals employed in this field.

This year we conducted several studies that provided us precious insights into the forms of risky behaviours among the youth, we evaluated the efficiency of our programs and continued working on the improvement of our organisation capacities. A particularly important improvement is our creation of the first comprehensive Strategy for Addiction Prevention in the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina, making our role and contribution in shaping the policies in this field stronger.

Our mentorship program *Older Brother, Older Sister* celebrated its 20th anniversary, whereas programs: *Who Actually Wins?*, *Let's Grow Up Together* and *Boombar* continued with their support of children and youth through innovative and interactive activities.

Through our media campaign *What do You Put at Stake?* we initiated the process of sensitising the public on gambling and betting issues in our society. We improved our co-operation with the public and private sector through the program *Healthy Working Environment For All*, investigating and addressing the problem of addiction at the workplace. Our already established program *Strong Families* has already spread to several communities and continued developing the resistance to stress with parents and children.

This report provides a detailed insight into our activities, achievements and lessons learned, as well as guidelines for future activities. We would like to thank all our partners, volunteers, and donors who contributed to the implementation of our aims through their engagement. Together we build a society in which prevention is a priority and in which every individual has a chance for healthy and high-quality living.

PORODICA

Snažne porodice

Preventivni program *Snažne porodice* koji provodi Udruženje za prevenciju ovisnosti NARKO-NE, dobio je službeno odobrenje UNODC-ja (*Ured Ujedinjenih nacija za borbu protiv droga i kriminala*) za implementaciju u BiH. U oktobru 2024. godine održan je trening za trenere programa, kojem su prisustvovala **Alma Hadžiskakić** i **Andrea Mijatović** čime je osigurano da su ove dvije predstavnice Udruženja za prevenciju ovisnosti NARKO-NE jedine dvije licencirane i ovlaštene osobe za provođenje ovog programa u BiH. Program se provodi kroz edukaciju stručnjaka u sektoru socijalne zaštite, a usmjeren je na pružanje podrške porodicama kako bi savladale svakodnevni stres i podsticale zdrav razvoj djece.

Obuku je uspješno završilo **47 saradnika** iz: Tuzle (*Dom za djecu bez roditeljskog staranja*, Udruženje *Sretno dijete* i *Savjetovalište za brak i porodicu Islamske zajednice*), Kalesije (*Centar za socijalni rad*), Maglaja (*Centar za socijalni rad* i *Medžlis Islamske zajednice*) Zenice (*Udruženje Mreža roditelja*), Kaknja (*Savjetovalište za brak i porodicu Islamske zajednice*), Breze (*Centar za socijalni rad*), Sarajeva (*Dom za djecu bez roditeljskog staranja*, *Porodično savjetovalište*, *SOS Dječija sela BiH* i Udruženje za prevenciju ovisnosti NARKO-NE), Mostara (*SOS Dječija sela BiH*), Livna (*Udruga PUŽ* i *Medžlis Islamske zajednice*), Istočne Ilidže (*Centar za socijalni rad*).

Tokom protekle godine, u program je bilo uključeno **87 roditelja** (82 majke i 5 očeva), dok je učešće djece bilo gotovo ravnopravno – od 85 učesnika, bilo je **45 dječaka i 40 djevojčica**.

Kako bi se osigurala kvalitetna realizacija programa, održano je **15 monitoring sastanaka** sa saradnicima. Educirani stručnjaci imaju sve potrebne materijale i metodologiju kako bi uz podršku i nadzor stručnih osoba, nastavili provoditi program u svojim zajednicama.



Ono što me motiviralo da se prijavim na ovu edukaciju je sam naziv "snažne porodice" jer svi smo svjedoci da živimo u vremenu sa mnogo izazova i rizika i da je zapravo porodica ta koja predstavlja temelj i snagu za budućnost svih nas. Vidjevši sve to, a i sadržaj programa željeli smo da se i mi kao osobe osnažimo kako bismo mogli prenijeti ta znanja na naše zajednice.

Prevention program *Strong Families* implemented by the Association for Addiction Prevention NARKO-NE received an official approval from UNODC (United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime) for implementation in Bosnia and Herzegovina. Training for program trainers was held in October 2024 and two representatives of the Association for Addiction Prevention NARKO-NE, **Alma Hadžiskakić** and **Andrea Mijatović** attended it and became the only two authorised persons for implementation of this program in Bosnia and Herzegovina. The program is implemented through education of experts in the field of social protection, and it is directed to the family support to overcome the everyday stress and encourage the healthy development of children.

The training was completed by **47 associates** from: Tuzla (Home for children without parental care, Association "Happy Child", and Islamic Community Counselling Centre for Marriage and Family), Kalesija (Centre for Social Work), Maglaj (Centre for Social Work and Majlis of the Islamic Community), Zenica (Association "Parents' Network"), Kakanj (Islamic Community Counselling Centre for Marriage and Family), Breza (Centre for Social Work), Sarajevo (Home for Children without Parental Care, Family Counselling Centre, SOS Children's Villages of BiH and Association for Addiction Prevention NARKO-NE), Mostar (SOS Children's Villages BiH), Livno ("PUŽ" Association and Majlis of the Islamic Community), Istočna Ilidža (Public Institution Centre for Social Work).

In the last two years, the program included **87 parents** (82 mothers and five fathers), whereas the children's participation was almost equal - of 85 participants, there were **45 boys and 40 girls**.

To provide the high-quality implementation of the program, **15 monitoring meetings** with associates were held. Educated experts have all the necessary materials and methodology to continue the implementation of this program in their communities with the support and monitoring of experts.

Zvijezde vodilje

Projekt Zvijezde vodilje tokom 2024. godine ostvario je saradnju s **5 osnovnih** i **3 srednje škole** te *Odgojnim centrom Kantona Sarajevo*, fokusirajući se na učenike uzrasta do 15 godina. Kroz realizaciju preko **50 edukativnih radionica**, **120 sati podrške u učenju**, **100 sati volontiranja** u Odgojnom centru, **8 grupnih savjetodavnih sastanaka** i **8 radionica za rad na sebi** za volontere obuhvaćeno je **249 učenika** i **27 volontera**. Evaluacije provedene sa stručnim osobljem u školama i **213 učenika** u **7 osnovnih i srednjih škola** su pokazale porast općeg znanja učenika, timsku koheziju u razredima, ali i zadovoljstvo volontera sadržajem i metodologijom rada.

Ovaj projekat imao je izuzetno pozitivan uticaj na učenike naše škole, pružajući im vrijedne životne vještine koje će im koristiti u svakodnevnim situacijama, kako u školi, tako i van nje. Kroz radionice koje su se bavile temama poput grupne pripadnosti, izražavanja emocija, komunikacije, asertivnosti, stupanja u kontakt s drugima, prevencije ovisnosti s fokusom na digitalne medije te vještina nošenja i rješavanja problema, učenici su stekli dragocjeno iskustvo i razvili sposobnosti koje doprinose njihovom ličnom razvoju i samopouzdanju...

Guiding Stars



In 2024, the *Guiding Stars* project established cooperation with **5 elementary** and **3 secondary schools** and the *Education Centre of the Sarajevo Canton*, focusing on students up to the age of 15. Through the implementation of over **50 educational workshops**, **120 hours of support in learning**, **100 hours of volunteering** at the *Education Centre*, **8 group counselling meetings** and **8 self-help workshops** for volunteers, the activities included **249 students** and **27 volunteers**. Evaluations conducted with professional staff in schools and **213 students** in **7 elementary and secondary schools** show improvement in students' general knowledge, team cohesion in classes, and volunteers' satisfaction with the content and methodology of work.

This project has had an extremely positive influence on the students at our school, providing them with valuable life skills that will benefit them in everyday situations, both in and out of school. Through workshops on topics such as group affiliation, expressing emotions, communication, assertiveness, getting in touch with others, addiction prevention with a focus on digital media, and coping and problem-solving skills, students acquired valuable experience and developed abilities that contribute to their personal development and self-confidence...

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Ko zapravo pobjeđuje?

Tokom realizacije projekta *Ko zapravo pobjeđuje?* licencirano je **7 stručnjaka iz BiH** za provođenje edukacije školskih timova, a ukupno je **27 provoditelja** obučeno za realizaciju programa u Sarajevskom (7) i Tuzlanskom kantonu (20). Program je proveden u **20 srednjih škola**, i obuhvatio je ukupno **1.407 učenika**, **215 nastavnika** i **112 roditelja**. U sklopu projekta realizovano je **8 okruglih stolova** i **2 panel diskusije**.

Obavljena je evaluacija učinkovitosti ovog programa uz samoprocjenu zadovoljstva i subjektivne dobiti učenika sa **520 učesnika** iz **14 škola**. Rezultati evaluacije jednoznačno ukazuju na visoku učinkovitost ovog programa u podizanju i jačanju zaštitnih faktora kod učenika, posebno u kontekstu povećanja nivoa ispravnog znanja o kockanju i industriji igara na sreću i upućuju na njegovu važnost u prevenciji problema s kockanjem među mladima te potrebu širenja ovog i razvoja sličnih programa.

Potpisani su protokoli o saradnji sa Ministarstvom obrazovanja i nauke Tuzlanskog kantona, Pedagoškim zavodom Tuzlanskog kantona i Edukacijsko-rehabilitacijskim fakultetom Univerziteta u Tuzli o provođenju programa u srednjim školama i sa Institutom za razvoj preduniverzitetskog obrazovanja Kantona Sarajevo koji je program uvrstio u Katalog posebnih i vannastavnih programa u Kantonu Sarajevo, čime se omogućilo da se program realizuje u svim prvim razredima srednje škole u Kantonu Sarajevo, a osigurava i samoodrživost programa.

Radionica u školi je bila sjajno iskustvo. Učenici su uživali u aktivnostima, naučili smo nove stvari i razvili korisne vještine. Profesorica je bila izvrsna i podsticala nas je na učešće. Svi smo naučili mnogo toga i zabavili se. Radionica je bila vrlo korisna i nadamo se da će ih biti još u budućnosti.

Sprovedena je kampanja *Šta stavljaš na kocku?* čiji ciljevi su bili uticati na stavove, norme i ponašanja zajednice u vezi s kockanjem/igrama na sreću, povećati svijest građana/građanki o tome koliki uticaj kockanje ima na živote pojedinaca i porodica i prevenirati nastanak problematičnog kockanja.

Ključne poruke kampanje:

- Vrijeme i novac izgubljeni kockanjem ne mogu se vratiti.
- Dobici stečeni kockanjem nisu „laka para“ jer se ukupno uloži više nego što se dobije.
- „Talenat“ ili oslanjanje na prethodne ishode kockanja nisu preduslov za siguran dobitak.
- Kockanje nije odgovor na probleme, potrebu za zabavom/uzbuđenjem ili bijeg od dosade, druženjem, rizikom i nije glamurozno.

Who Actually Wins?

During the implementation of the project *Who Actually Wins?* **7 experts** from Bosnia and Herzegovina were licensed for school team education, and **27 implementers** in Sarajevo Canton (7) and Tuzla Canton (20) were trained for the implementation of this program. The program was implemented in **20 secondary schools** and it included **1,407 students**, **215 teachers** and **112 parents**. As part of the project, **8 round-table sessions** and **2 panel discussions** were held.

Efficiency was assessed through self-assessment of satisfaction and subjective gain of students with **520 participants** from **14 different schools**. The results of the assessment unanimously indicate the Program's high efficiency in increasing and strengthening the protective factors with students, especially in the context of increasing the right knowledge about gambling and games of chance, indicating the importance of the prevention among the young and the need to improve this and develop similar programs.

Protocols on cooperation were signed with the Ministry of Education and Science of the Tuzla Canton, the Pedagogical Institute of the Tuzla Canton and the Faculty of Education and Rehabilitation of the University of Tuzla on the implementation of the program in secondary schools, and a protocol on cooperation with the Institute for the Development of Pre-University Education of the Sarajevo Canton. The Canton, which included this program in the Catalogue of special and extracurricular programs in the Sarajevo Canton, enabling the program to be implemented in all first grades of secondary schools in the Sarajevo Canton, and the self-sustainability of this program is ensured.

A campaign *What are you putting at stake?* was conducted to influence attitudes, norms and behaviour of the community regarding the gambling/games of chance, increase the awareness of citizens about the influence of gambling on the lives of individuals and families and prevent the emergence of problematic gambling.

The key messages of the campaign:

- "Time and money lost in gambling can't be refunded."
- "Winnings gained by gambling are not "easy money" because you invest more than you win."
- ""The talent" or reliance on earlier gambling outcomes are not a precondition for safe winning."
- "Gambling is not an answer to problems, a need for fun/excitement or running away from boredom, socialising and "It is not glamorous."

were posted on billboards and city lights in Sarajevo, Tuzla and on social media, reaching **over a million people**.

The workshop at school was a great experience. Students enjoyed activities, we learned new things and developed useful skills. The teacher was great and she initiated us to participate. 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Odrastimo zajedno

Program *Odrastimo zajedno* se zasniva na pristupu unapređenja životnih vještina, promovise zdravlje i razvoj ličnosti djece od 6 do 10 godina, učenika prvog do četvrtog razreda osnovne škole. Program se tokom školske godine u školama realizovao kroz sedam radionica u trajanju od po 45 minuta. Djeca su, u skladu sa individualnim potrebama i kapacitetima, razvila vještine rješavanja problema, donošenja odluka, suočavanja s emocijama, unaprijedila samosvijest, empatiju, komunikacijske vještine, te kreativno i kritičko mišljenje.

U školskoj 2023./2024. godini program je provodilo **30 učitelja** iz **11 osnovnih škola**, obuhvatajući **503 učenika**, a u tekućoj školskoj godini (2024./2025.), educirana su **32 nova učitelja** iz **12 škola**, uključujući **5 novih škola**. Planirano je da program realizuje **51 učitelj** te obuhvati **1.165 učenika** iz **14 osnovnih škola**.

Samoodrživost programa osigurava saglasnost resornog ministarstva i motivisanost učitelja koji prepoznaju njegovu vrijednost.

Sadržaji radionica Odrastimo zajedno su veoma kreativni, zanimljivi i učenicima veoma privlačni. Učenici s velikim nestrpljenjem iščekuju realizaciju sljedeće aktivnosti. Radionice kod učenika razvijaju životne kompetencije, sadrže strategije koje vode ka ostvarenju ishoda. Ono što je pohvalno je da smo dobili sve materijale za radionice, kako za nas, tako i za učenike. Nastavljamo da odrastamo zajedno!

Let's Grow Up Together



The program *Let's Grow Up Together* is based on an approach to improve life skills, and promote the health and personality development of children from 6 to 10, children from the first to the fourth grade of elementary school. During the school year, within this program, schools implemented seven 45-minute workshop sessions. According to their individual needs and capacities, children developed skills for problem-solving, decision-making, dealing with emotions, developing self-awareness, empathy, communication, and creative and critical thinking.

In the school year 2023/2024, the program was conducted by **30 teachers** from **11 elementary schools**, including **503 pupils**, and in the current school year (2024/2025), **32 new teachers** from **12 schools** were trained, including **5 new schools**. The program is planned to be implemented by **51 teachers** and includes **1,165 pupils** from **14 elementary schools**.

The self-sustainability of the program is provided through the approval of the relevant ministry and the motivation of teachers who recognise its value.

The content of the Let's Grow Up Together workshops is very creative, interesting and very attractive to pupils. Pupils are eagerly anticipating the implementation of the next activity. Workshops develop pupils's life skills and contain strategies that lead to the achievement of results. What is commendable is that we received all the materials for the workshops, both for us and for the pupils. We continue growing up together!

RADNO MJESTO

Zdravo radno okruženje za sve

Tokom 2024. godine poseban fokus Programa bio je na uspostavljanju saradnje sa *Zavodom za javno zdravstvo FBiH* i *Udruženjem poslodavaca FBiH* i na provođenju *Istraživanja nadzora i zaštite zdravlja zaposlenika u Federaciji BiH s fokusom na bolesti ovisnosti*. Cilj istraživanja bio je analizirati prisutnost pušenja, konzumacije alkohola, psihoaktivnih supstanci te kockanja/klađenja na radnom mjestu u vladinom, nevladinom i privatnom sektoru kao i postojanje procedura i pravilnika kojima se uređuje prevencija ovisnosti na radnom mjestu. Ovo istraživanje je prvo takve vrste od 2012. godine, kada je prethodno istraživanje ZZJZFBiH bilo usmjereno na hronične bolesti i opće zdravstveno stanje zaposlenika.

Istraživanjem je obuhvaćeno **104 ustanove, kompanije i nevladine organizacije**, čime je osiguran reprezentativan uzorak i relevantnost rezultata. Zaključci i preporuke te izvještaj o rezultatima istraživanja koji ukazuju na potrebu za profesionalnim radom i unapređenjem pristupa i standarda poslovanja u oblasti prevencije ovisnosti na radnom mjestu, podijeljeni su sa svim partnerima i učesnicima, a ustanovama, kompanijama i nevladinim organizacijama ponuđena je mogućnost učešća u programu prevencije ovisnosti u narednoj godini.



U implementaciji ovog značajnog istraživanja, ispred Zavoda za javno zdravstvo Federacije BiH bilježimo odličnu saradnju sa Udruženjem za prevenciju ovisnosti NARKO-NE, koja je bila praćena međusobnim poštovanjem, profesionalnošću, dobrom komunikacijom, i razvijanjem odličnih partnerskih odnosa koji su rezultirali uspješnom realizacijom Istraživanja nadzora i zaštite zdravlja zaposlenika u Federaciji BiH sa fokusom na bolesti ovisnosti.

Sa velikim zadovoljstvom, Zavod za javno zdravstvo Federacije BiH nastavlja dalju saradnju sa Udruženjem za prevenciju ovisnosti NARKO-NE i radujemo se zajedničkom djelovanju na unapređenju javnog zdravlja u BiH.

Healthy Working Environment For All

In the implementation of this important research, on behalf of the Institute of Public Health of the Federation of BiH, we note excellent cooperation with the Association for Addiction Prevention NARKO-NE, which was accompanied by mutual respect, professionalism, good communication, and the development of excellent partnership relations that resulted in the successful implementation of the Survey of Supervision and Protection of Employee Health in the Federation of BiH with a focus on addictive diseases. During 2024, a special focus of the program was on establishing cooperation with the *Institute of Public Health of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina* and the Association of Employers of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina, and on conducting *Research on employee health surveillance in the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina with a focus on addictive diseases*. The research aimed to analyse the presence of smoking, alcohol consumption, psychoactive substances, and gambling/betting in the workplace in the government, non-government, and private sectors, as well as the existence of procedures and obligations regulating addiction prevention in the workplace.

The research included **104 institutions, companies and non-government organisations**, providing a representative sample and relevance of the results. The conclusions and recommendations, as well as the report on the research results that indicate the need for professional work and improvement of access and business standards in the field of addiction at workplace were shared with all partners and participants, and institutions, companies and non-government organisations were offered the opportunity to participate in the addiction prevention program in the coming year.

U sklopu Boombar projekta **16 mladih volontera, srednjoškolaca**, uspješno je educirano o prevenciji ovisnosti i unapređenju zdravlja. Realizovano je **8 radionica** za razvoj ključnih životnih vještina poput timskog rada, asertivne komunikacije i suočavanja s emocijama, a evaluacija ciklusa pokazala je napredak u razvoju vještina, posebno rješavanja problema, i samopouzdanja.

Volonteri su učestvovali na **6 događaja** s mobilnim barom, uključujući: *Sajam zapošljavanja mladih* u Mostaru u organizaciji Caritas BiH, *završna radionica Zahvalni susret za mlade Future centra SOS Dječijih sela BiH*, *Creative Fest Burch univerziteta*, interne događaje u Travniku i Sarajevu. Na ovim gostovanjima, Boombar volonteri su pripremili oko **650 bezalkoholnih koktela**.

Razvijen je priručnik za standardizaciju radionica, a evaluacija je pokazala i visoku zainteresovanost mladih za učešće u projektima prevencije u slobodnom vremenu kao što je Boombar.

Osim što sam stekla nova znanja i vještine, naučila sam kako bolje saradivati s drugima, nositi se sa problemima, biti odgovorna i vjerovati u sebe. Boombar



As a part of the *Boombar* project, **16 young volunteers**, secondary school students, underwent a successful education on addiction prevention and health improvement. **8 workshops** for the development of key life skills such as teamwork, assertive communication, and dealing with emotions were implemented. The evaluation of the cycle showed progress in the development of skills, especially problem-solving, and self-confidence.

Volunteers participated in **6 events** with a mobile bar, including: *Youth Employment Fair* in Mostar, organised by *Caritas BiH*, the *final workshop Thankful Meeting for the Young at Future Centre* by *SOS Children's Villages BiH*, the *Creative Fest of Burch University*, internal events in Travnik and Sarajevo. At these events, *Boombar* volunteers prepared about **650 non-alcoholic cocktails**.

A manual for workshops standardisation was developed. The evaluation also showed a high level of interest among young people in participating in leisure-time prevention projects such as *Boombar*.

Apart from acquiring new knowledge and skills, I also learned how to collaborate better with others, deal with problems, be responsible, and believe in myself. I learned how important it is to be patient and open to new ideas. Boombar allowed me to grow and develop, to express my opinion and to build self-confidence. I am very grateful for all the lessons I adopted and the wonderful people who helped me to make it possible.

Stariji brat, starija sestra

Mentorski program *Stariji brat, starija sestra* (SBSS) je pružao podršku djeci u riziku, djeci iz institucija, hraniteljskih porodica i socioekonomski ugroženih porodica kroz mentorstvo i druženje s volonterima. Realizovan je u saradnji sa *KJU Dom za djecu bez roditeljskog starenja Bjelave*, *Kantonalnim centrom za socijalni rad Sarajevo*, Udruženjem *Dajte nam šansu*.

Volonteri su, uz podršku projektnog tima i saradnika iz socijalnih ustanova, individualno radili s djecom pomažući im u učenju, organizaciji slobodnog vremena i suočavanju s kriznim situacijama, što je doprinosilo boljoj socijalnoj uključenosti, izgradnji pozitivnih modela ponašanja i razvoju životnih vještina kod djece. Evaluacija programa pokazuje razvoj stabilnih i podržavajućih odnosa između djece i volontera, pozitivan uticaj na razvoj samopouzdanja, socijalnih vještina i otpornosti kod djece, dok su volonteri dobili priliku za lični razvoj.

Obilježavanje 20 godina programa SBSS upriličeno je nizom aktivnosti od kojih je važno spomenuti *festival Odrastimo zajedno* koji je organizovan u saradnji sa *Fondacijom "Stariji brat, starija sestra"*, koji je u *Centru za edukaciju, sport i rekreaciju "Safet Zajko"* u Sarajevu okupio veliki broj djece i volontera iz cijele BiH. Održana je konferencija *"20 godina inspiracije i rasta"* u *Dječijoj kući* u Sarajevu uz na kojoj je prikazan film koji promovise značaj i postignuća ovog programa. U okviru događaja pružena je podrška ranije pokrenutoj inicijativi za integraciju programa *Stariji brat, starija sestra* u sistem socijalnih usluga, čime bi se osigurala dugoročna podrška za djecu u potrebi i održivost programa.

Tokom 2024. godine u program je bilo uključeno **84 volontera**, koji su realizovali **600 individualnih mentorskih susreta** sa **41 djetetom** i **16 grupnih aktivnosti** za više od **170 djece**.



Program SBSS nam je donio mnogo radosti i novih iskustava. Kao volonterka, imala sam priliku biti uz mlađu sestru i kroz zajedničke aktivnosti doprinosti njenom razvoju i samopouzdanju. Older Brother, Older Sister



The mentoring program *Older Brother, Older Sister* (SBSS) provided support to children at risk, children from institutions, foster families and socio-economically disadvantaged families through mentoring and socialising with volunteers. It was implemented in cooperation with the *Cantonal Public Institution Children's home Bjelave*, *Cantonal Centre for Social Work, Sarajevo Canton*, *Association Give Us a Chance*.

Volunteers supported by the project team and associates from social institutions, worked individually with children, helping them learn, organise their free time, and deal with crises, which contributed to better social inclusion, building positive behavioural models, and developing life skills in children. The program evaluation shows the development of stable and supporting relationships between children and volunteers, positive influence on the development of self-confidence, social skills and resilience with children, while volunteers got a chance for personal development.

The celebration of the 20th anniversary of the *Older Brother, Older Sister* program was made through a range of activities whereby it is very important to mention the festival *Let's Grow Up Together* organised in collaboration with the *Foundation Older Brother, Older Sister*, gathering a great number of children and volunteers from the whole country of Bosnia and Herzegovina in the *Centre for Education, Sport and Recreation "Safet Zajko"* in Sarajevo. A Conference "20 years of Inspiration and growth" in *Children's House* in Sarajevo was held and accompanied by a film that promotes the significance and achievements of this program. Within this event, a support for an earlier initiative for integration of the program *Older Brother, Older Sister* into the social service system was supported, which would provide a long-lasting support for children in need and sustainability of this program.

In 2024, the program included **84 volunteers** and they implemented **600 individual meetings** with **41 children** and **16 group activities** for more than **170 children**.

The program Older Brother, Older Sister brought many happy moments and new experiences for us. As a volunteer, through our mutual activities, I had an opportunity to be with a younger sister and contribute to her development and self-confidence. Specifically, Older Brother, Older Sister taught us both about the importance of togetherness, patience and mutual trust, and enriched our lives in many ways. We also have great coordinators who are professional, experienced, forthcoming and above all, good persons. They provide excellent support and create a safe environment for us volunteers and children, enabling everyone to feel safe and enjoy the time we spend together.

ISTRAŽIVANJA I EVALUACIJE

Istraživanje o kockanju i korištenju interneta, navikama konzumiranja duhanskih proizvoda, alkohola i marihuane je obuhvatilo **1.066 ispitanika** u **27 osnovnih i srednjih škola** u **24 općine** iz **3 kantona** u FBiH (Kanton Sarajevo, Zeničko-dobojski kanton i Srednjobosanski kanton). Provedeno je među učenicima uzrasta od 13 do 17 godina, a ispitani su i načini na koje mladi provode slobodno vrijeme, odnos između stilova roditeljstva i konzumacije različitih sredstava ovisnosti, kao i školske politike vezane za konzumiranje duhanskih proizvoda i alkohola u školskom okruženju. Rezultati su dostupni na www.prevencija.ba i bit će korišteni za strateško planiranje i kreiranje budućih intervencija.

Tokom godina, volonteri su bili korisnici ali i resurs koji je Udruženje za prevenciju ovisnosti **NARKO-NE** podržavalo u preventivnim i drugim aktivnostima u različitim okruženjima. Proveli smo analizu u kojoj je učestvovalo **122 volontera** te su prikupljene korisne informacije koje se odnose na motivaciju volontera, njihove potrebe, fokuse budućih edukacija i nagrađivanje kao vid održavanja motivacije, a preporuke za dalji rad i mobilizaciju volontera su podijeljene i sa partnerskim organizacijama.

Obavljena je eksterna evaluacija projekta *Uspostava mreže prevencije ovisnosti* provedenog u periodu od septembra 2021. do augusta 2024. koja je prihvaćena od strane donatora, a dobijene preporuke će biti uvrštene u pripreme za strateško planiranje.

Kroz proces analize procjene organizacijskih kapacitet od strane Instituta za razvoj mladih **KULT/POK** potvrđene su ključne oblasti, planirani su i unaprijeđeni organizacijski procesi u oblastima tehničke i IT podrške, organizacijske održivosti i pružanja usluga korisnicima. U 2024. godini izrađena su pisana pravila upravljanja imovinom, uspostavljen je sistem monitoringa i evaluacije, te kreirani standardi kvalitete pružanja usluga.



RESEARCH AND RESEARCH AND EVALUATIONS

A total of **1,066 respondents** from **27 elementary and secondary schools** from **24 municipalities** of **3 cantons** in the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina (Sarajevo Canton, Zenica-Doboj Canton, and Central Bosnia Canton) were included in the research on gambling and internet use, and habits of consumption of tobacco products, alcohol, and marijuana.

The research was conducted among students between 13 and 17. The research also dealt with the way young people spend their free time, the relationship between parenting styles and the consumption of various addictive substances, as well as school policies related to the consumption of tobacco and alcohol in the school environment. Results are available at www.prevenција.ba and will be used for strategic planning and development of future interventions.

Throughout the years, volunteers have been users but also a valuable resource supported by the Association for Addiction Prevention NARKO-NE in preventive and other activities in various settings. We conducted analysis with **122 volunteer participants**. With our partner organisations, we shared useful information about the motivation of volunteers, their needs, the focus of future training and awarding as the form of maintaining the motivation, and recommendations for further work and mobilisation of volunteers.

An external evaluation of the project *Establishment of an Addiction Prevention Network*, implemented from September 2021 to August 2024, was conducted and accepted by donors. The recommendations received within this evaluation are to be included in the preparations for strategic planning.

Through the analysis of the assessment of the organisational capacities by the Institut for Youth Development KULT/POK, key areas were confirmed, the organisation processes in areas of technical and IT support, organisational sustainability, and provision of services to users were planned and improved. In 2024, rules on property management were adopted, a monitoring and evaluation system was established, and quality standards for provision of services were created.

U ovoj godini NARKO-NE je aktivno učestvovao na dva ključna međunarodna događaja u oblasti naučno utemeljene prevencije: na 15. konferenciji *Evropskog društva za preventijska istraživanja EUSPR*. u Cremoni (Italija)), te na *Lisbon addictions* događaju u Portugalu gdje smo predstavili iskustva provođenja *EUPC* obuka u BiH.

Nakon intenzivnog rada na pripremi sadržaja i izradi teksta dokumenta, završene su i javne konsultacije čime je nastavljen proces izrade *Strategije za prevenciju ovisnosti u Federaciji BiH za period 2024-2034.* godine i pratećeg akcionog plana, za što je zaduženo *Federalno ministarstvo obrazovanja i nauke* u saradnji sa Udruženjem za prevenciju ovisnosti NARKO-NE i formiranom radnom grupom koju sačinjavaju i predstavnici *Federalnog ministarstva unutrašnjih poslova, Federalnog ministarstva pravde, Federalnog ministarstva rada i socijalne politike, Federalnog ministarstva zdravlja i Federalnog ministarstva kulture i sporta.*

Održane su tri obuke u okviru *Evropskog preventijskog kurikuluma* u skladu sa evropskim standardima prevencije: u Livnu, Bihaću i Goraždu, na kojima je učestvovalo ukupno 57 osoba. Učesnici su profesionalci iz oblasti obrazovanja, zdravlja, sigurnosti, donosioci odluka, predstavnici vjerskih i nevladinih organizacija iz ovih gradova. Obuke su proveli Amir Hasanović, Andrea Mijatović i Sanela Pečić, jedini licencirani treneri za Bosnu i Hercegovinu.

U okviru programa međunarodne volonterske razmjene, ostvareni su kontakti sa organizacijama iz inostranstva i sedam volontera su posredstvom Udruženja za prevenciju ovisnosti NARKO-NE pripremljeni i podržani u svojim angažmanima u Njemačkoj i na Malti tokom 2024., a neki od ovih angažmana se nastavljaju i dalje.

Tokom 2024. godine studentsku praksu, na osnovu potpisanih sporazuma o saradnji između *Fakulteta političkih nauka Univerziteta u Sarajevu* i Udruženja za prevenciju ovisnosti NARKO-NE, u *udruženju* je obavilo devet studenata. Pored praktičnih znanja i vještina u oblasti socijalnog rada, studenti su u direktnom provođenju aktivnosti imali priliku saznati više o oblasti prevencije ovisnosti i praktičnim primjerima intervencija usmjerenih na prevenciju ovisnosti.

Uspostavljen je protokol *Udruženja za prevenciju ovisnosti NARKO-NE* i otvorena mogućnost za dostavljanje komentara, pohvala i žalbi učesnika u programima,

saradnika i partnera uključenih u rad i aktivnosti NARKO-NE-a čime smo podigli nivo transparentnosti u radu i omogućili objektivne sugestije za unapređenje rada Udruženja.

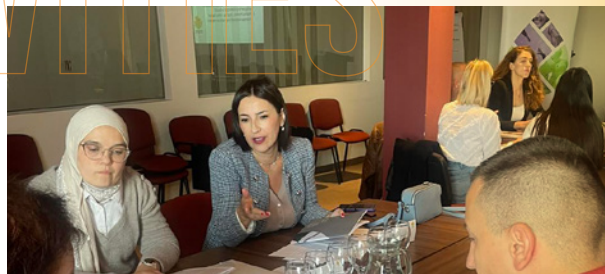

IN 2024



In this year, NARKO-NE actively participated in two key international events in the field of science-based prevention: *The 15th Conference of the European Society for Prevention Research EUSPR*, and the *Lisbon Addictions Event* in Portugal where we presented our experience of EUPC Training implementation in Bosnia and Herzegovina.

The protocol of the Association for Addiction Prevention NARKO-NE was established and there is a possibility to deliver comments, praises and complaints of the program participants, associates and partners who take part in the work and activities of NARKO-NE thereby increasing the transparency level in our work and enabling impartial suggestions for improvement of our Association's work.

After intense work on preparation of the content and text of the documents, public consulting was completed, we continued the process of developing the *Strategy for Addiction Prevention in the Federation of BiH for the period 2024-2034* and the accompanying action plan, which is the responsibility of the *Federal Ministry of Education and Science* in cooperation with the Association for Addiction Prevention NARKO-NE and the working group consisting of representatives of the *Federal Ministry of Internal Affairs*, the *Federal Ministry of Justice*, the *Federal Ministry of Labour and Social Policy*, the *Federal Ministry of Health* and the *Federal Ministry of Culture and Sports*.

To facilitate organising workshop sessions, training sessions, meetings and everyday work of the employees of the Association for Addiction Prevention NARKO-NE, the premises in Sarajevo, at Hermann Gmeiner 13 and Hermann Gmeiner 16, as well as the office for research, monitoring and evaluation in Josipa Vancaša 21 were renovated, providing better conditions for high-quality work of our team and further professionalisation and development of addiction prevention with partners and associates.

Three training sessions as part of the *European Prevention Curriculum* according to the European drug prevention quality standards were held in Livno, Bihać and Goražde, where 57 persons participated. Participants include professionals from the fields of education, healthcare, security, decision-making, religion and non-government organisation representatives from these cities. Training sessions were conducted by: Amir Hasanović, Andrea Mijatović and Sanela Pekić, the only licensed trainers for Bosnia and Herzegovina.



As part of the international volunteering exchange, we established contacts with foreign organisations and by mediation of the *Association for Addiction Prevention NARKO-NE*, seven volunteers were prepared and supported in their engagement in Germany and Malta during 2024, and some of them are still actively engaged.

In 2024, nine students had their student practice as per signed collaboration agreements between the *Faculty of Political Sciences of the Sarajevo University* and the Association for Addiction Prevention NARKO-NE. Apart from practical knowledge and skills in the field of social work, students had a chance to learn more about the addiction prevention and practical examples of interventions directed at addiction prevention.

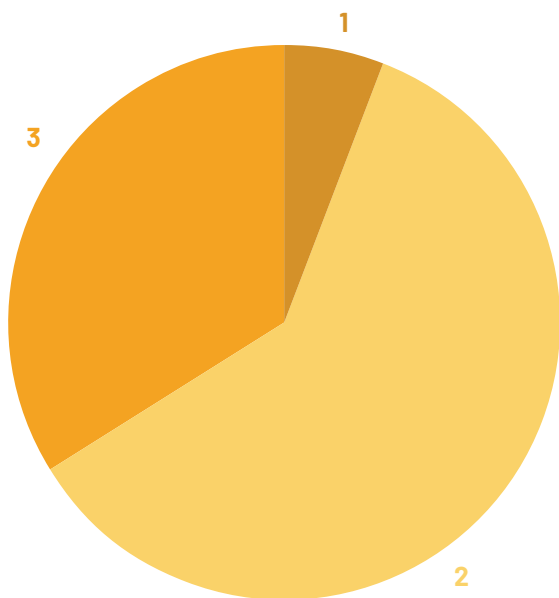

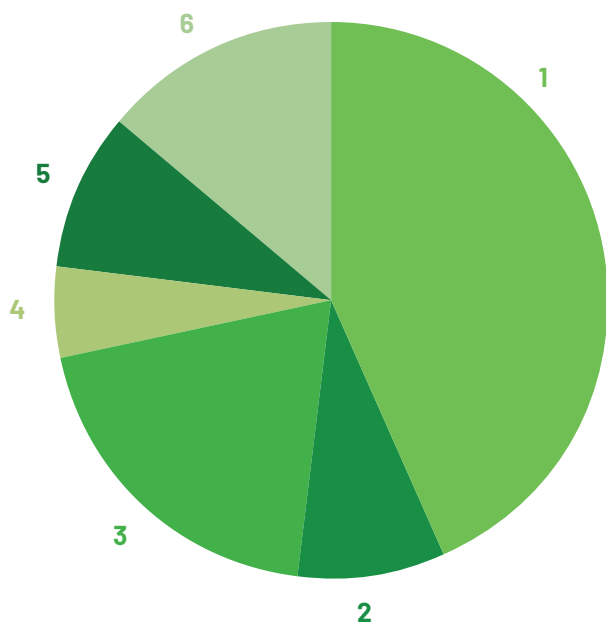

Udruženje za prevenciju ovisnosti NARKO-NE nastavlja s ključnim iskoracima u promociji naučno utemeljene i djelotvorne prevencije, jačajući integrisane i interdisciplinarne pristupe u svim temeljnim životnim okruženjima. Kroz strateško unapređenje svojih programa i inicijativa, Udruženje se usmjerava ka uspostavljanju održivog i holističkog modela prevencije, zasnovanog na socio-emocionalnom učenju, ranoj intervenciji i jačanju otpornosti djece i mladih.

PLANS FOR 2025 – Statement of the Steering Board

Association for Addiction Prevention *NARKO-NE* continues with key steps forward in promoting the science-based and efficient prevention, strengthening integrated and interdisciplinary approaches in all living environments. Through strategic improvement of its programs and initiatives, the Association focuses on the establishment of the sustainable and holistic model of prevention, based on socio-emotional learning, early intervention and strengthening the resilience of the young.

Strategically important step forward in 2024 is professionally-consultant role of the Association in preparation of the first comprehensive strategy for addiction prevention in the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina. This initiative establishes a systematic, multidisciplinary and sustainable framework for prevention, relying on the contemporary scientific research, international guidelines and proven models of efficient prevention practices. The development of strategy includes a wide range of actors – from decision-makers and professionals from healthcare, education and social protection to civil society organisations and academic community, providing an inclusive and comprehensive access.

Association's direction of acting in future focuses on the implementation of measures defined in this strategy, but also the promotion of quality standards in the addiction prevention. *NARKO-NE* continuously invests in the education of key experts who work with children and youth, including teachers, psychologists, and social workers, to ensure application of science-based and evidence-based efficient prevention methods.

Also, the research and evaluations remain key tools for improvement of the existing prevention programs and development of new evidence-based interventions. Systematic collection and analysis of the empirical data will enable more precise recognition of risk factors and protective factors, better directing of the prevention programs and

achieving the largest possible public-health and social effects.

Association *NARKO-NE* continues its mission through strategic initiatives and innovative access, creating foundations for a sustainable and efficient addiction prevention system in Bosnia and Herzegovina.
